

A short visit of Temse



Temse is undoubtedly one of the most beautiful towns in the Waasland. The town was several times the decor of numerous TV feuilletons (with Man and Macht, Silent Waters) and all the great (Belgian) cartoonists let their heroes wander around in Temse. No coincidence, Temse breathes past, present and future.

The monumental old town hall of Temse, a pearl in eclectic style, and the gothic and neogothic O-L-V-kerk are eye-catchers of the marketplace. The quirky shape of the church tower has been a landmark in the region for centuries.

Temse was also inextricably linked to the Boelwerf (1829-1994). On that site arose new housing establishments, SMEs and the new town hall - AC the Zaat. Hereby the Temse skyline has been redrawn for a few years now.

Along the quay you will find a lot of sculptures such as the Tuyscher and the Azijnzeker (spot names of the inhabitants of Temse) and the Kaailopers (including the Mekker, the Schele Wringer, brown Pear, and other dock workers from before WW II).

Even a switch to 'Buitenland' and the oldest lock of the country in Weert are within walking distance via the two bridges over the Scheldt.



- 10:30** Arrival, individually or by bus at the Wilfordkaai in Temse.
- 10:45** Walk along the sights of Temse with guide.
- 12:45** End of walk.
- 13:00** Boarding on board the ship at the Wilfordkaai + meal.
- 14:00** Departure 'Silent Water Boat Tour'. The boat trip takes you to the poetic Sint-Amands and Mariekerke, along the lade of the Durme and the Rupel, Hamme-Driegoten, Weert, The Notelaer in Hingene, the abbey of Hemiksem,... The places where the series 'Stille Waters' was recorded. This boat trip on the Scheldt brings you nature, peace and relaxation.
- 17:45** End of the cruise.



When:

Throughout the year. Please contact us for the different dates.

Prices:

- > Boat trip: varies according to the number of participants, e.g. for the ship Mozart: € 11 p.p. at 100 participants, € 15 p.p. at 75 participants, € 20 p.p. at 55 participants.
- > Guide visit Temse and nautical explanations on board: € 167.50 / guide for a whole day. Attention: depending on the size of the group an extra guide must be provided for the visit of Temse.
- > Meals are possible from € 13 p.p. (cold dish)
- > Transport between the different places of interest: you can reserve a bus yourself. Bus reservation is also possible via Rivertours.
- > EXTRA ADVANTAGE: on Sundays are more favorable rates possible, even for smaller groups. The hours of the program will be slightly adjusted.
